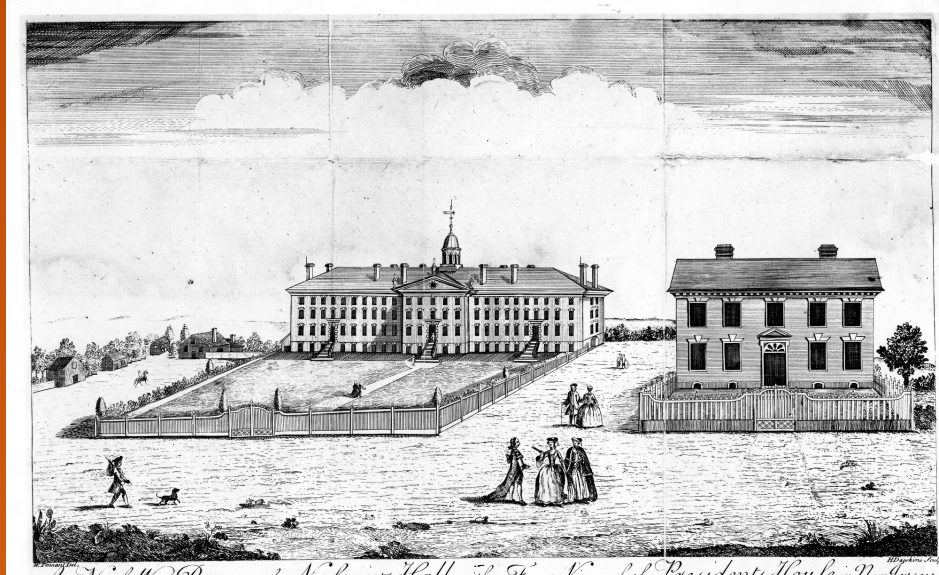




"Princeton The Nation's Capital 1783"

**The American Revolution shooting war had ended

ongoing in Paris. In June 1783, Congress, in
