Metal/White Goods Recycling



The Department of Public Works provides a weekly curbside collection of household appliances and items that are mostly made of metal/iron. These items include but are not limited to household appliances (refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, air conditioner units, dehumidifiers) metal patio furniture, lawn mowers and tractors, tires (on or off rims), bicycles, basketball hoop poles, exercise equipment & weights and metal bed frames.

Doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezer before placing at curb.

Oil and gas must be removed from lawn mowers and tractors.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Please contact Public Works office (609) 799-8370, 24 hours in advance, to arrange for curbside pick-up. Curbside pick-ups occurs every Friday, if a Friday collection day falls on a holiday, curbside pick-up will occur on the previous business day. Any calls for pick-up received after 3:00pm on a Thursday, will be added to our next week's pick-up list. Please place your item by the curb no later than 6:30am the morning of the arranged curbside pick-up.

Residents are welcome to bring their white goods/appliances/metal goods to our Public Works facility during our resident drop-off hours if more convenient.
