Updates from Health Officer

- Quarterly report was distributed
- Reminded the Public many Health Department resources can be found on the Township Website
- Dates for Influenza clinics to be posted on Township Website
- Reminded residents to maintain property to discourage breeding of mosquitos and sidewalk safety for school children
- Gave an update and education on PFAS chemicals. Health Department planning outreach within the community on September 3<sup>rd</sup> to remind well water residents to test their wells on an annual basis. More information can be found in the Township Lobby and on the website


